FROM THE DESK OF THE MAYOR...



Dear Port Residents,

Happy New Year!

I am proud to say we made it through the year with lots of high points. Here is a look back into 2024:

The voters passed a referendum for Port Republic School which was a huge learning curve, especially for our City Clerk, Brandy who had to navigate a system that even the county was unsure of. The referendum was a big help to the future of our school. Council passed the redevelopment plan and awarded the job of managing the filling of our gravel pit with clean dredgings which will start by the end of this year, once all permits are obtained. Extra revenue is always a good thing. The contract for the rebuilding of the basketball/tennis court/ and added pickle ball courts was awarded and the project will begin in the spring. The financing of the project all fell into place which in the beginning seemed insurmountable. All the funding is now in place for this new recreational area.



The city sold the old city garage to the Heritage Society who is in the process of raising money to refurbish this building into a place to house Port Republic artifacts and a community meeting space.

This year we had a Mile Stone celebration for our volunteer fire fighters during Port Day to recognize the 30 volunteers and their commitment to keeping us safe. I am so impressed with their dedication. Cameras have been installed upgrading our security system with more cameras to come this year. We completed the paving of Mill Road with grant money and received grants for the repaving of Adams and Pomona Ave. which will be done in the upcoming year.

Our long time city clerk Kim Campellone retired and our new team member, Lisa Morris was hired as our new deputy clerk and is now involved in the very long process of learning how to negotiate all of the ever changing tasks. This has been a particularly hard year for Brandy, with so many changes and unknowns, but she approaches each day with a smile on her face and always goes above and beyond what is expected. Our DPW team members Dave and Kyle under the direction of Bill Montag have done an incredible job in Port.

We are so fortunate to have Scott Winneberger as our emergency management coordinator. I had gone to the Fire House, which was set up as the central command base, when we had the missing person incident and was over whelmed by the efficiency and organization of the all professionals that came to help.



I am so grateful for the pirate ship playground that was installed on January 2nd. With the direction of Bill and Kathy Smallwood. The Port Republic Athletic Fund paid to have it built, with the city only paying for the labor to install the perimeter and the mulch. Already it is a big hit with our younger residents even in the cold weather. The city is applying for a recreational grant so hopefully we will be able to add more items to play on in the coming year.

We have welcomed a new Council Member, David Crawford. He has already jumped in as a recreation and personnel committee member and we are looking forward to him being part of our team. I am so proud to be mayor of such a unique place. Sometimes it is over whelming to think that the decisions we make have a huge impact on our future generations. I pray for wisdom for each one of us and the realization of how fortunate we all are to be here in Port Republic. I can't wait to see what 2025 has in store for us!

To ensure your child's Kindergarten registration can be completed at your scheduled appointment, please be sure to have met all necessary requirements and have forms listed below:

Incoming Kindergarten students should accompany parents to registration

Age Requirement:

Child MUST be 5 years old on or before October 1st of the school year for Kindergarten.

Enrollment Packet:

Available by request or visit school website www.portnj.org

Certificates/Identification:

Proof of residency (tax bill, deed, lease, Affidavit if Renting w/o lease), Valid Photo ID + 2 bills w/address

Original Birth Certificate – issued by the state or local Registrar of Vital Statistics, or for foreign born children, a report issued by the U.S. Consular Service. **Student Guardianship/Custody Papers:** If applicable

Immunization Records (up to date): You will have an opportunity to meet with our school nurse Including, DTaP-4 doses, with 1 dose after the 4th birthday, or any 5 doses, two doses of MMR, completed Hepatitis B vaccine series, Polio, Chickenpox (Varivax) vaccination.

Physical:

Verification from student's physician of physical within 365 days of the first day of school.

As you may know, the Port Republic Heritage Society is in its third year of operation. We have acquired the city's First Fire House(built in 1929) from the City and are anxious to begin the hard work of transforming this old building into a museum where we can preserve and share documents, artifacts and old photographs of this great town.

The work to rehabilitate this old building which has been largely unused for a decade will be considerable and costly. We need a new roof, work to replace or repair interior walls, insulation, doors and windows replacements, new heating/air conditioning system, masonary ,electrical and plumbing upgrades and a new bathroom in order to bring the building up to current standards for public use.

The Heritage Society has been working to raise the funds needed for this important project. We've held two fundraising events and sold Port Republic memorabilia (T-shirts, Christmas ornaments and commemorative booklets for Port's past events). We are in the process of applying for a state approved raffle license and we are having a Chinese auction fundraiser on Sat. March 29th, 2025 at The Carriage House(information attached).


